FEES AND EXPENSES: This contract is for an **Early Booking Breeding Fee** of **\$850.00**. This special price is only good for breedings booked by **11/30/23 by emailing back signed agreement and making arrangements for the deposit**. The advertised stud fee for One Special Asset for 2024 is \$1000.00 per mare. A deposit of **\$250** to be returned with this agreement to book the breeding. The balance of the stud fee **\$600.00** is due prior to breeding or first shipment. Please endorse any checks to the stallion owner: Todd Olsen but mail with this contract to the stallion manager, Theresa Rorabaugh at Twin Creek Farms LLC, 18075 4 Mile Rd., Morley, MI 49336. **SHIPPING EXPENSE:** The shipping expense is \$300 for Federal Express Priority Overnight service. All stallion collections & the cost of shipments are responsibility of the mare owner. If Fed Ex shipment requires a Saturday delivery, then mare owner is responsible for the extra fee that Fed Ex requires for that service. Shipment expenses are subject to change based on fare increases. **ALL SHIPPED SEMEN REQUEST MUST BE MADE 24 HOURS PRIOR TO SHIPMENT DATE BY CONTACTING Theresa Rorabaugh (616) 813- 4095**. Collection days are Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. The Breeder has the right to deny shipping requests that are giving in an untimely manner. **BREEDING SEASON:** The Breeding Season as used in this Breeding Contract shall refer to the period from February 1st – August 1st of the year of this Breeding Contract.

MARE BREEDING CONDITION: Mare Owner warrants and represents that Mare is in sound breeding condition, free from any infection or disease. Any Mare determined by a licensed veterinarian not to be in sound breeding condition shall not be bred to Stallion. Upon determination that a Mare is not in sound breeding condition, Mare Owner may substitute another Mare for breeding to Stallion, subject to all the terms of this Breeding Contract.

MARE OWNER RESPONSIBILITY: The responsibility for conception is on the Mare Owner. A qualified, experienced and licensed veterinarian or technician competent in the use and handling of cooled semen should perform the insemination. If Mare fails to conceive from first shipment, it is suggested that Mare Owner have Mare cultured by a licensed veterinarian and infused, if necessary, before considering a second shipment of cooled semen.

COLOR GUARANTEE: The resulting foal from the breeding of the above named mare will be eligible for Regular Registration in the appropriate breed.

LIVE FOAL GUARANTEE: Mare owner is guaranteed one live foal for Mare once she has been certified by Breeder to have settled. A "live foal" shall be defined as a foal that stands and nurses. If Mare miscarries her foal or if the foal is stillborn, Mare Owner shall be entitled to rebreed Mare to Stallion the following breeding season, provided, however, that within one week of Mare miscarrying or producing a non-viable foal, Mare Owner provides Breeder

written notification from a licensed veterinarian certifying that Mare has slipped the foal or produced a foal that did not stand and nurse. The live foal guarantee will be extinguished should the Stallion die or become sterile. Rebreed handling fee for the following year is \$250.00. STALLION: If the Stallion should die or become unfit for service, then this Agreement shall automatically terminate and the Stallion Owner shall refund to the Mare Owner the full stud fee, within the calendar year. WAIVER OF LIABILITY, RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS: MARE OWNER HERBY SPECIFICALLY AGREES THAT STALLION OWNER, TWIN CREEK FARMS LLC AND THEIR AGENTS, EMPLOYEES, OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, VETERINARIANS, GUESTS, INSURERS, AND ATTORNEYS (THE "RELEASED PARTIES") SHALL NOT BE LIABLE AND SHALL BE RELEASED AND HELD HARMLESS FROM ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, CAUSES OF ACTIONS, EXPENSES AND DAMAGES OF ANY NATURE RESULTING FROM OR RELATING TO BREEDING STALLION TO MARE, INCLUDING ANY ESCAPE, ACCIDENT, INJURY, SICKNESS, DISABILITY, AND/OR DEATH OF MARE AND/OR FOAL AS WELL AS ANY ESCERCISES OF JUDGMENT BY THE RELEASED PARTIES IN CONNECTION WITH THE CUSTODY AND CARE OF THE STALLION, MARE AND/OR FOAL. MARE OWNER UNDERSTANDS AND SPECIFICALLY REPRESENTS THAT THE PROTECTION FOR THE MARE OWNER TO COVER ANY POTENTIAL LOSS REGARDING MARE AND/OR FOAL IS TO OBTAIN INSURANCE FOR SUCH LOSS. MARE OWNER UNDERSTANDS AND IT IS MARE OWNER'S RESPONSIBILITY AND CHOICE WHTHER TO OBTAIN INSURANCE.

LIQUDATED DAMAGES: As between Mare Owner and any of the Released Parties described in the waiver of Liability, Release and Hold Harmless provision, should any dispute arise that in not otherwise governed or covered by a provision in this Breeding Contract, the Parties hereby specifically agree that damages, expenses, costs and fees, including attorney's fees for such dispute, whatever the nature of the dispute, shall be limited to the sum of \$1,500.00.

ARBITRATION: All claims and disputes arising under or relating to this Contract are to be settled by binding arbitration in the state of Michigan or another location mutually agreeable to the parties. An award of arbitration may be confirmed in a court of competent jurisdiction.

BREEDER'S CERTIFICATE: A Breeder's Certificate produced by the appropriate Association will be issued to the Mare Owner as shown on the Mare's registration papers, after all fees and expenses have been paid in full and upon notification to Todd Olsen: (tolsen@bcpsk12.net) or (616)-299-1877 of the birth of the foal.

REGISTRATION PAPERS: Mare Owner shall provide Breeder a copy of the Mare's registration papers (front) at the time of the execution of this Breeding Contract. The Owner of record on the registration papers shall be the owner recorded on the Stallion Breeding Report.

VENUE AND JURISDICTION: All disputes related to this Breeding Contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of Michigan. Mare Owner agrees that personal jurisdiction and venue of all such disputes shall be in Ottawa County, Michigan.

DISCLAIMER: Breeder makes no representations or warranties, express or implied, regarding the delivery of the cooled semen delivered under this Breeding Contract, and shall not be responsible for delayed , lost or mishandled deliveries. Semen will be collected only on established breeding days and no representations or warranties are made or implied that cooled semen will be available at the time requested by the Mare Owner, although every effort will be made by Stallion Owner to make the cooled semen available upon request of the Mare Owner.
